We provide outstanding education for children aged 2-18. Our campus is made up of our three schools:

- The Pre-Prep School, for ages 2-7
- The Prep School, for ages 8-13
- The Senior School, for ages 14-18



Our pupils follow the British Curriculum. This leads to IGCSEs and a choice of 21 different A Level subjects, which helps them achieve places at the world's best universities. Each pupil benefits from world-class, innovative teaching on our state-of-the-art campus, and pastoral care delivered through a traditional House system.

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OUR CAMPUS

OUR CURRICULUM

Our reputation as one of the top international schools in Bangkok is based on how we encourage pupils to strive for academic excellence whilst being the best version of themselves.

Our teaching is based firmly on the British National Curriculum to make sure that pupils are prepared for all stages of their education. Our world-class teachers nurture a love of learning while encouraging pupils to explore their interests. From Pre-Prep through to Senior School pupils are guided to develop a wide range of skills.

Pupils are given the freedom to choose subjects that they are passionate about. In addition to the core subjects - English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities - pupils can choose a range of options at both IGCSE and A Level.

Our international community inspires us to offer a number of modern foreign languages, including Thai and Mandarin for all pupils up to Year 4.

ADMISSIONS

The admissions process at Brighton College varies slightly depending on the age of the applicant. In general, admission is based on a combination of entry assessments, interviews and references.

Brighton College is a leading independent school in England. In 2019 it achieved the highest examination results for any co-educational or boarding school in England. The College was recently voted England's Independent School of the Year 2019 by the Sunday Times, which praised its culture of kindness and commitment to academic excellence.

Each year Brighton College pupils secure places as the world's most esteemed universities, particularly Cambridge and Oxford, where over 150 former pupils have studied in the last five years. Former pupils - affectionately known as Old Brightonians - include some of the foremost business, professional and political leaders, as well as national athletes, artists, actors and musicians.

These are all important points when considering a school for your child - but most important is their happiness. Visitors regularly comment on the warm and vibrant atmosphere at our school, and The Sunday Times declared we are a "a school where confidence, kindness and curiosity are championed." There is no Brighton College 'type', and each child is valued for who they uniquely are.

Founded in 1845 by William Aldwin Soames, who collected a group of like-minded local citizens to join him in the task, Brighton College was the first independent school to be founded in Sussex, England. Since the beginning the school has been a pioneer of innovation in education: we invented the school magazine (1852), set up the first gymnasium (1859) and created the first purpose-built science laboratory (1871).

We continue being forward-thinking today. This equips our pupils with the skills they need to succeed at university and beyond.

Brighton College International School Bangkok is a part of this journey. The success of Brighton College UK provides the foundation for this world-class school in South-East Asia.
